Entrance Requirements

There are no specific requirements for entry into the program; however you are required to be 18 years old to be licensed as a Real Estate Broker.

Credit for Previous Training

Clock-hour credits cannot be given for previous training or education unless approved by the Real Estate Agency of Oregon.

School/Class Schedule

This On-line study program is available wherever and whenever the students get a suitable internet connection. Access information is delivered through the provided e-mail address. Additional contact information is available via the school website, 'Contact Us" page. Students can study in our Salem office during normal office hours. End of subject exams must be taken in the school office during normal office hours.

Attendance Policy:

Students are given 1 year to complete their course of study. An extension is available if the student is progressing well and their extension request is approved.

Grading System--Pass/Fail:

To pass, the student must successfully complete the program by completing the required number of clock hours in each course and passing the seven (7) subjects, final exams with a score of 75% or better.

Progress Standards:

Students must accumulate the required study time in each subject and pass the subject exam and final exam in order to get a completion certificate.

Disciplinary Policy:

Students are required to comply with all school rules. The school administration maintains the right to dismiss students for violating school rules, or for conduct that reflects unfavorably on the schools reputation or interferes with the operation of the school.

Reinstatement After Termination:

If a student is terminated for any reason, re-admittance will be permitted only if agreed to by school officials, based on their evaluation of the individual case.
